

Irish Concrete Society Visit 'Cedar Brook'

A large group of over 50 architects, engineers and students turned out to a very successful site visit to the 'Cedar Brook' development in Cherry Orchard Co. Dublin, by the Irish Concrete Society. 'Cedar Brook' is the first public/private social housing initiative, in conjunction with Dublin Co. Council to address the need for social affordable housing. The winning consortium consisted of Park Developments and John Sisk Ltd. and was designed by DBFL and O'Mahony Pike Architects.

Those attending were treated to a joint presentation by John Sisk Ltd and the Concast Precast Group. The Irish

Concrete Society was particularly interested in the application of precast concrete throughout the development which comprises 374 units, of which approximately 50% are apartments and 50% are houses. The units were built using Concast's precast concrete widelsab flooring, stairs, landings, internal and external wall panels, pre-finished in terracotta and cream.
