Seminar June 17th 2004

The New Concrete Standards - An Introduction

Venue: The Great Southern Hotel - Cork Airport
Half Day - Starting 2pm



An important half day seminar dealing with The New Concrete Standards I.S. EN 206 - 1 will take place in Cork on Thursday June 17th. The event is organised jointly by the Irish Concrete Society, The Irish Concrete Federation and the IEI and will feature a range of speakers from varied backgrounds in the construction industry, including cement manufacture, concrete manufacture and building contracting. The seminar

provides an introduction to the new standards and the process of specifying concrete to I.S. EN 206-1, and its production and supply by concrete manufacturers. A specially prepared brochure explaining the new code (see page 4) will be launched at the Seminar.

On December 1st 2003, I.S. EN 206-1 became the only national standard specification for concrete in Ireland. New test standards for concrete also came into

force. All current specifications will have to be revised to comply with I.S. EN 206-1 and its requirements. New terminology and new approaches to specification of certain aspects of concrete will have to be adopted.
